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Directions From Chattanooga Airport:

1. Head south on Airport Connector Rd 0.2 mi
2. Slight left to stay on Airport Connector Rd 0.8 mi
3. Turn right to merge onto TN-153 S 1.2 mi
4. Keep right at fork, follow signs for I-75 S/Atlanta/Chattanooga 2.7 mi
5. Slight left to stay on I-75 S 1.1 mi
6. Take exit 1 for US-41 S 0.2 mi
7. Turn left onto US-41 S/Ringgold Road 1.2 mi
8. Turn left onto Orchid Lane – Destination on right

Directions From Atlanta Airport:

1. Merge onto I-85 N via the ramp to I-75N/Atlanta 12.0 miles
2. Continue straight onto I-75 N 103.0 miles
3. Take exit 353 for Georgia 146 towards Rossville/Fort O 0.3 miles
4. Turn right onto GA-146 E/Cloud Springs Rd 0.6 miles
5. Turn left onto GA-3 N/US-41 N 0.5 miles
6. Turn right onto Orchid Lane – Destination on right
